Sub: Request of the school for Composite Provisional Affiliation up to Secondary level (Category) - regarding.

With reference to your online application SL-02366-1718 dated 01.07.2016 on the subject directed to convey the sanction for Provisional Affiliation for Secondary School Examination for a period of three years i.e. 01.04.2017 to 31.03.2020.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is **1631209**. This may please be noted for any further correspondence with the Board.
2. The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and course of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination as therein from time to time.
3. The school must submit its information through Online Affiliated School Information as per the Board's Circular No: CBSE/Aff./4/Circular/2016, dated 10.11.2016, within the receipt of this grant letter. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website : www.cbse.in.
4. It is case of switch over from State Board; the school is required to withdraw its affiliation from State Board as dual affiliation is not permissible. Also State Board classes IX will not be held from **01.04.2017**. However, for the Class X Examination to be held in the year 2019, the school can admit its students for State Board only.
5. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Regt. Govt from time to time.
6. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as per Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under:

	Campus area	Enrolment	No. of Sections (pre-primary)
(a)	1.0 acre	1250	02 in each class
(b)	1.5 acre	1875	03 in each class
(c)	2.0 acre	2500	04 in each class
7. School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted to actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned above.
8. Schools running on less than 01 acre campus in metropolitan cities shall restrict number of students as under:

	Category	Area of land	No. of students
(i)	Secondary School	2000 sq. mtrs	600 upto Class VIII
(ii)	Sr. Secondary School with two streams	3000 sq. mtrs	900 upto Class X
9. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. Relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in the library and would be 1500 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.
10. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Board concerned.
11. The school is required to restrict the number of sections as per the infrastructure facilities available in the school as per rule 10.6 of Affiliation Bye-laws; the number of students in the class should not exceed the optimum number. The optimum number of students in a section of a class should not be more than 40 and number of sections in middle, secondary and senior secondary level of the school shall preferably be proportionate to the number of students.
12. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers. It would ensure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software along with facility of internet connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider to be ensured.
